

Summer Junior Golf League

At Worcester GC

Ages: 17 & Under

General Information

- Open to boys and girls who play the game. “Play the game” means: the junior the golfer knows and can demonstrate Safe, Fast, and Courteous behavior on the golf course and surrounding golf club facility. Also, boys and girls are scoring between 45 and 60 for 9 holes, have taken lessons, know general rules and etiquette, and play frequently with and without adult supervision. Recommended for Intermediate/Advanced junior golfers.
- **Program Starts:** League will meet every Wednesday starting June 27th to August 15th . Starts at noon with tee times at 8 to 10 minute intervals. No League on July 4th.
- **Program Description:** League players will tee off at Noon. Diane will form groups of 3 to 4 golfers. Tee times will be at 8 to 10 minute increments. Golfers will play 9 holes, keep score, and a fun contest will be set up each week. Diane Rama, LPGA Teaching Professional will be on the course with the golfers until 2pm providing help/guidance for those golfers that she sees needs help. After golfers are done 9 holes, groups will add up there scores and return their scorecards to pro shop.
- Registration, reading and understanding Expected Behavior & Requirements for participation in league, and Junior League Contract signing are required to participate in league.
- **League Fee:** \$50p/p (includes 1 hour clinic with Diane and prize fund) **Extra fee:** weekly 9 hole greens fee/ pull cart fee paid in pro shop before play.

Summer Junior Golf League

Requirements for participating in league

The junior golf league is open to boys and girls who play the game, “play the game” means the golfer knows and can demonstrate Safe-Fast-Courteous play on the golf course and the surrounding golf club facility, and has played and is comfortable playing unsupervised golf.

Examples of Safe Golf: The junior golfer holds club properly while waiting to play, remains behind tee markers while waiting for their turn to play, demonstrates safe actions at all times on course and around golf club facility without adult supervision or reminders, and knows to hit when the group in front is a safe distance away.

Examples of Fast Play: The junior golfer is ready to play when it’s their turn, can play 9 holes in 2 hours or less, keeps pace with group in front, has sufficient golf skills (gets ball in hole in 3 putts or less, can chip and pitch ball with appropriate loft and distance, can make a full swing with appropriate tempo, balance, and finish), knows to get to golf course 30 minutes before tee time (checks in clubhouse/pro shop area to pay greens fee and is ready to play well before their tee time, and knows some basic rules-etiquette-order of play, and can display acceptable behavior on the course and golf club facility.

Examples of Courteous Play: The junior golfer is expected to be respectful to juniors participating in league, golf club employees, members/patrons of Worcester GC, and will not trespass on private property of the homes surrounding Worcester GC. All junior golfers must dress appropriately (collared shirt, shorts/pants with pockets, sneakers or golf shoes.) Please no Tank Tops, cut off jeans, soccer shoes. If you are not sure of what to wear please contact Diane Rama. All juniors must have their own clubs with bag (No Sharing of clubs)

The Goal of league is to give the junior golfer an opportunity to play with other kids, improve their golf skills, and to have fun!

Summer Junior League

Course Rules, Clubhouse Rules & Expected Behavior

- All play will be from Red Tee Markers.
- **8 Stroke Limit** – if golfer's ball is not on green by 8 strokes the golfer must pick up ball and place ball on green and putt out from there.
- **All Groups Must Keep Pace With The Group In Front.** If you fall behind you must pick up your pace of play or you may be asked to skip a hole to catch up with group in front.
- **Please Stay Off Private Property Of Homes Around Golf Course.** If your ball goes on a home owner's property, do not retrieve ball, instead drop a ball as near as possible to where ball went in and add a 1 stroke penalty to your score.
- Hole #8 – If tee shot goes into water, go to Drop Area behind 9th tee, drop ball here and add a 1 stroke penalty to your score.
- Please replace all divots, fix any ball marks you make on putting green, rake bunker and leave rake on edge of bunker.
- Please Be Courteous To The Other Players In Your Group. Be quiet when others are hitting, stand a safe distance (to the side, not in front or behind) from others when they are hitting. No Throwing Of Clubs Or Inappropriate Language. You may be asked to leave league if you break this rule.
- Return All Scorecards To Pro Shop.
- Dress Code – collared shirts, shorts or pants with pockets, golf shoes or sneakers (No soccer or baseball shoes). If you are not sure what is appropriate to wear please contact Diane Rama.
- **Clubhouse and Golf Course Courtesy** – Please be respectful to golf club employees and Worcester GC members/patrons. We encourage you to stay for lunch but all junior golfers must eat at tables (not at bar). If you stay for lunch please be on your best behavior in and around clubhouse area.
