Frequently Asked Questions

Should I take a clinic or individual instruction? If you are brand new to the game or have been away from the game for a long time Diane recommends signing up for her Intro to Golf Program. If you are a golfer with playing experience, in a rut, wanting to get to the next level Diane recommends her Intermediate Player Improvement Clinics or Individual instruction.

<u>Need clubs?</u> Clubs will be provided at no charge for your use during lesson or clinic. Please let Diane know what you (Right or Left Handed club) in advance.

When do I pay for my lesson/clinic? Clinic payment is due at time of registration to reserve your spot in the class. Registration form can be found on Diane's Instructional page of her website. Please print out and send payment to Diane. Individual, Semi-Private, Form Your Own Group, and Playing Lesson payment is due at the first lesson (payment in full). Diane accepts Cash or Check.

Where and When do we meet? If you have an Individual, Semi-Private, or Form Your Own Group lesson plan on arriving at least 10minutes prior to your lesson. You will purchase range balls for your lesson in the Pro Shop and Diane will meet you at the Driving Range. If you signed up for a Group Clinic plan on arriving at least 10 minutes prior to the clinic time and Diane will meet you at the Driving Range. If you have a Playing Lesson, plan on arriving at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time to leave you enough time to: get your golf shoes on, bag ready, and to check in at the pro shop to pay for your on course fees. Diane will meet you at the pro shop/first tee area.

What should I wear? Dress comfortably. Please No jeans, tank tops, or tee shirts. Get into the habit of checking prior to playing local golf courses in the area if they have a dress code to avoid any issues with attire. Golf shoes, they are helpful but you can play in flat soled athletic shoes. Wearing a golf glove will help with your grip and reduce the chance of getting blisters.

What about weather cancellations? In the event of inclement weather, your lesson or class may need to be rescheduled. Diane will attempt to contact via text, phone, or email in the event of a weather cancellation. If the weather looks threatening where you are and you have not heard from Diane, call or text Diane at 215-896-3764 to check for cancellations.

Where can I practice? Head to Worcester GC. We have a grass practice area to work on your full swing, chipping, putting, and sand bunker techniques. Purchase range balls in the Pro Shop.
